

FpA Residency Program + Fellowship

INTRODUCTION

The FpA Fondazione per l'Arte offers Fellowships and A.I.R. Program in the Italian capital Rome.

FELLOWSHIPS are open to visual artists, architects, designers, performing artists, writers and other arts and creative professionals.

RESIDENCIES are open to professionals without regard to location. The FpA Fellowships and Residencies provide an opportunity for the recipients to undertake a project related to current or anticipated professional work.

FpA FELLOWSHIP

This Fellowship covers the costs of restricted coach-class airfare/train for one person (up to € 500), a € 1,500 stipend, and lodging for one month at the FpA residency at Mandrione in Rome.

OTHER PROGRAMS

RESIDENCES

Residency applicants are independent professionals who will be responsible for their own support and will have full access to the facilities and resources of the FpA spaces. Residents are charged a moderate fee for the use of their apartment/room, Studio and the facility. Please contact info@fondazioneperlarte.org for further information on fees. Applicants' project proposals are reviewed by the FpA Board for merit and appropriateness to the FpA's mission. Minimum stay: 3 weeks. Maximum: 2 months. **Direct Application Period: Open year round.**

- **SPECIAL SOLO STUDIO:** the formula provides, in periods and duration to establish and define, the exclusive use of the space/studio, a working space of 300sqm and the apartment of 75 sqm located at Via del Mandrione Rome, to "only one" artist that needs a period of work, production and study, Working space and the accommodation "will be given to exclusive use " to a single artist.
- **CO-RESIDENCIES FOR ARTISTS AND CURATORS:** the project provides for the possibility , up to 3 artists and/or curators simultaneously, the use of the working space and the accommodation for periods of study and/or work in the City of Rome. The studios will be assigned to the selected artists after submitting the application form together the required documents.

Technical Specifications Co-Residences FPA for artists and curators:

The Co-Residence consists in sharing the accommodation, a three totally independent rooms with a large bathroom in common apartment (75 sqm) and a working space of 300 square meters where the artists can work side by side. The living space and kitchen are common too and are located in a separate area in the large working space.

Artists and curators are selected considering the direct application, as well as the partner application. Thanks to exchanges with other international residences Organizations, **FPA promotes the opportunity for artists and curators to spend residence periods, study, work abroad.** as well as in the other Italian residency spaces our partners.

NOTE: Residency Applications may be submitted anytime and are reviewed by the Board of the FpA. Applicants are not restricted to any country and open to all with a vision.

Residency Applicant Requirements and Evaluation

Residency applicants are independent professionals who will be responsible for their own support and will have full access to the facilities and resources of the FpA space. Applicants are requested to provide the board with a full description of their proposed project along with the specific time frame requested and a statement of how their stay in FpA will further the Foundation's mission. Applicants may use our Fellowship Application form as a template for presenting their proposal, but using that form is not required. Applicants' project proposals are reviewed by the FpA Board for merit and appropriateness to the FpA's mission. Determinations regarding exact dates, length of stay, and accommodations will be made in consultation with the applicant.

Upon completion of their Residency, Residents are requested to contribute a written summary along with digital images or other materials representative of the applicant's work in Rome for permanent inclusion in the FpA archives.

Residents are charged a moderate fee for the use of their apartment/room, Studio and the facility. Please contact info@fondazioneperlarte.org for further information on fees. Minimum stay: 3 weeks. Maximum: 2 months. **Direct Application Period: Open year around.**

Location and Accommodation

- Studio/ workspace

This industrial hangar consists of 300 square meters of open space with a ceiling height of 7.10 meters. Its horizontal disposition with easy vehicle access facilitates the transport and installation of works. The space is fully accessible to the disabled and is also equipped with office space, living room and a kitchen. The working space is equipped with wireless connection. The space is located in an industrial/artisanal district and neighboring with space itself, are 50 different activities and suppliers that can provide and support for any artists needs, as well as materials and works.

- Accommodation

Adjoining the venue, the Foundation possesses a large and comfortable apartment planned for the accommodation of those artists that have been invited to take part in the Foundation's projects, and its programme of residencies. The apartment consists of three bedrooms, a bathroom, with huge common terrace in a one floor building. The dwelling is not air-conditioned.
