

In 2010 one hundred new AiR-programs were added to the Trans Artists database. Most of them were situated in Europe.

Is there a relation between the presence of AiR programs in a country and the amount of visits to the Trans Artists website?

Do AiR programs trigger the local curiosity among artists to participate in the AiR sector?

Below the maps from Google analytics show that the locations where visits to the Trans Artists website come from, are not limited to the local presence of AiR programmes. On the contrary. The maps show that the curiosity is widely spread throughout the respective countries. The amount of visits is most high in the national cultural centers, but spread all over the countries' provincial towns and villages.

### The Netherlands

The amount of visits increased: from 45.285 in 2009 up to 50.736 in 2010.

- \* 90 artist-in-residence programs in 25 cities.
- \* visits to Trans Artists website came from 424 cities.

Most visits came from Amsterdam (23.370), followed by Rotterdam (3.251), Utrecht (2.597), Den Haag (1.682) Groningen (1.151).

### Belgium

The amount of visits increased: from 6.147 in 2009 to 8.896 in 2010.

Most visits came from Brussels (1.927), followed by Gent (1.833), Antwerp (1.126), Sint-Josse-Ten-Noode (826), Borgerhout (597).

## Poland

The amount of visits from Poland nearly doubled: from 4730 in 2009 up to 8055 in 2010.

- \* 8 artist-in-residence programs in 6 cities
- \* visits to Trans Artists website came from 120 cities.

Most visits came from Warsaw (3161), followed by Krakow (824), Wroclaw (724), Poznan (605), Lodz (303).

## Brazil


The amount of visits from Brazil more than doubled: from 2,163 in 2009 up to 5,156 in 2010.

- \* 8 artist-in-residence programs in 4 cities.
- \* visits to Trans Artists website came from 110 cities.

Most visits came from Sao Paulo (1,772), followed by Belo Horizonte (1,327), Rio de Janeiro (782), Campinas (214) and Porto Alegre (179).

## India

The amount of visits from India increased with nearly 40%, from 3,839 in 2009 to 5,288 in 2010,

- \* 14 AiR programs in 12 cities.

\* visits to Trans Artists website came from 88 cities.
